Description of Toast POS SaaS Solution

Overview of Toast Solution for Marriott

Toast proposes the use of our Android-based restaurant Point of Sale (POS) platform. Our platform runs on robust hardware like our Toast Flex terminal, designed in-house to perform in demanding restaurant environments.

Toast's self-ordering Kiosks and Toast Go handhelds enable Marriott to streamline front-of-house labor requirements while providing the convenient ordering experience expected by modern guests across properties. In back-of-house environments, our integrated Kitchen Display System (KDS) can help properties increase kitchen efficiency, reduce order errors, and manage surging demand.

Toast is a highly-extensible platform offering a full API library and 170+ existing certified integration partners to enable our customers to build the right technology stack for their businesses and support internal development initiatives such as data warehousing. Our integration library includes existing Marriott partners like GiveX, SevenRooms, OpenTable, and Opera. Toast's flexibility extends to payments, although for Marriott we have developed an integration with FreedomPay.

The Toast Management Site (Toast Web), allows centralized corporate teams to fully support both corporate and franchised locations. Toast's granular permissions and enterprise menu management tools enable franchisors to have as much or as little control as needed, down to the property and location levels.

Data Center Quality Control & Storage Management

Toast is hosted on AWS servers. Core POS operations are performed locally on the tablet and communication to the cloud happens async, to avoid network latency.

Toast monitors and tracks latency through both cloud and device observability dashboards, setting internal alarming thresholds for investigation when latency is detected, depending on the service or device being monitored. Internal logging and tools are used to investigate any anomalies detected.

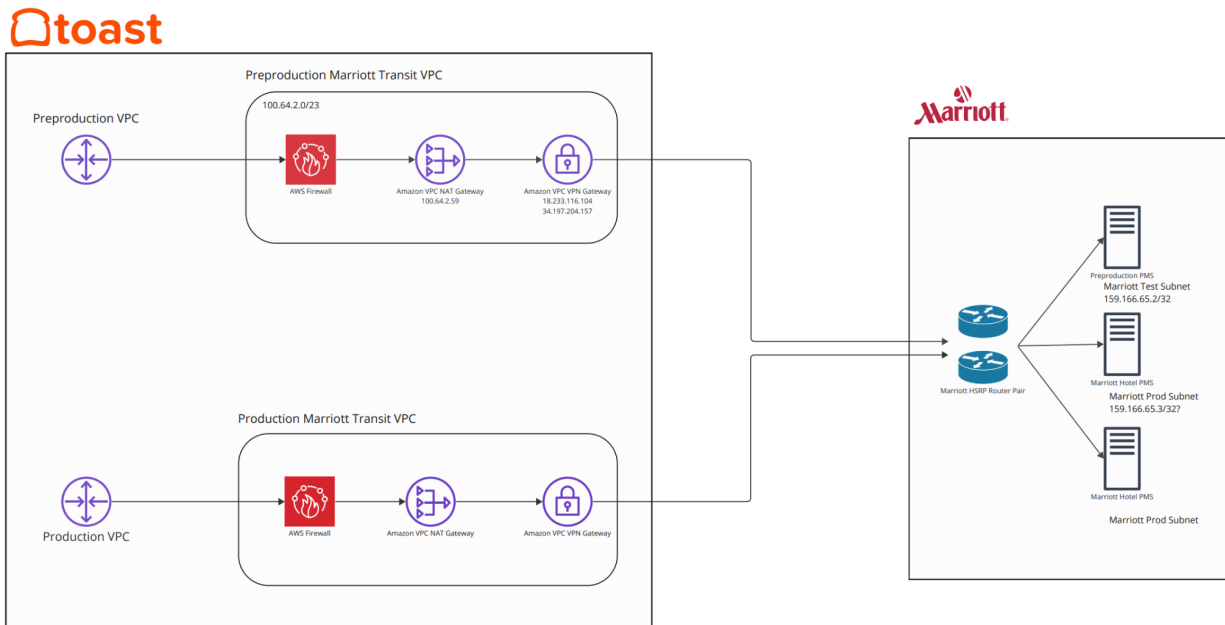
In our AWS-hosted environment, the risk of medium being removed from AWS data centers is low, both because of industry-leading stringent physical security measures, and also because of the fact that any single "drive" in the AWS environment is typically distributed across multiple physical media.



Redundant & Secure Gateways

Toast is using a native AWS VPN. All communication is initiated by Toast. The diagram attached below represents the state Toast requires for the VPN tunnels. This design offers Toast and Marriott a number of advantages relative to a single tunnel one:

- While Toast is capable of segregating traffic prior to the NAT Gateway with our firewall, based on whether it originates from our pre-production or production environment, Marriott cannot. From the Marriott firewall's perspective, all traffic always originates from [10.64.2.0/23](https://www.iana.org/assignments/iana-ipv4-special-assignments/iana-ipv4-special-assignments-10.64.2.0-23), and Marriott is unable to guarantee, in the event of a faulty configuration on the Toast side, that our pre-production could not talk to Marriott's production resources.
- There is a potential threat to production stability in the event that for example, a load test in a lower privileged environment consumes too many resources.
- It is important to have a secondary tunnel for testing purposes, should any configuration changes be needed over the life of the tunnel.







Toast Guardian MDM

All Toast devices have custom Android AOSP firmware with Toast Guardian, which is then provisioned as a device owner on the first power-on by the Property Owner. Once Toast Guardian is set up, the device is ready to use. There are some features of Toast Guardian that are important to note:









- Guardian allows for the ability to download Toast POS directly from the device
- Guardian prevents downloading of any 3rd party apps
- Guardian deletes any apps that are not approved by Toast



