Tips & Tricks:

- Subgroups can make a menu look nice and feel organized. When you don't use subgroups, it leaves all menus and groups visible from the item selection screen, meaning if I'm done selecting an item from the group, I can move to the food menu without having to click out of the menu I'm viewing.
- Subgroups unravel with Online Ordering -- for example, if we have pizza sizes in subgroups, they would be broken out of them online and be a messy group of pizza sizes jumbled together, which could be less thrilling for online ordering customers.
- Item Details and Images can show to Toast users as well to help describe or show a guest an item on the Toast Go!
- You can create a QR code for free on sites like https:// www.qr-code-generator.com/ and link your Online Menu to it so that guests can have a contactless experience when they sit down and scan a sticker on the table to see menus.
- You can add Android Emoji to Menus, Groups, Items and Modifiers.
